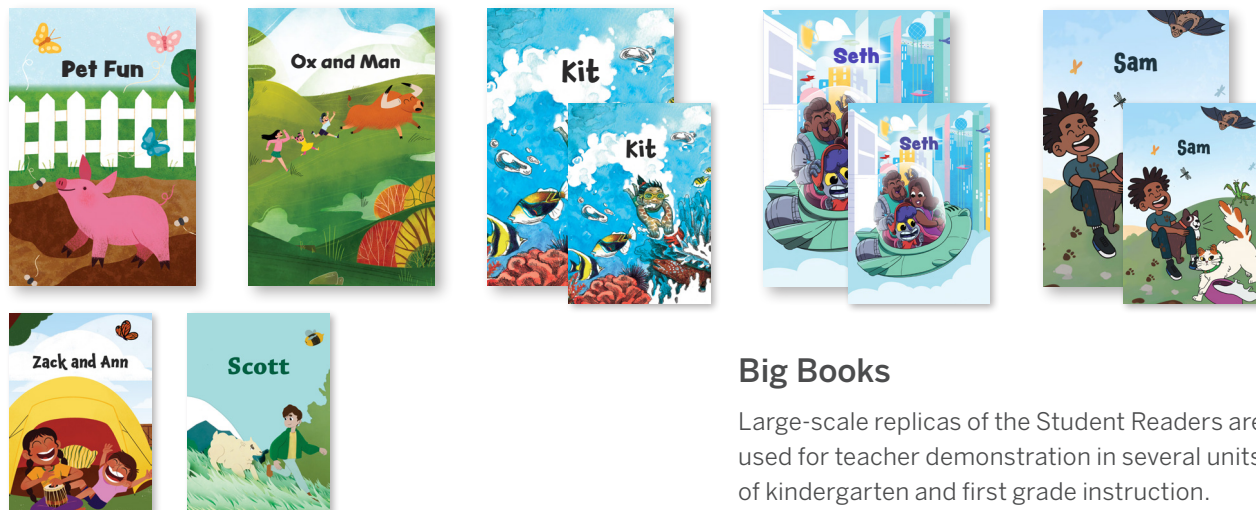

All of the Amplify CKLA® K–2 Skills Readers have been redesigned and reillustrated to increase student engagement and sense of connection with the decodable stories and their characters.

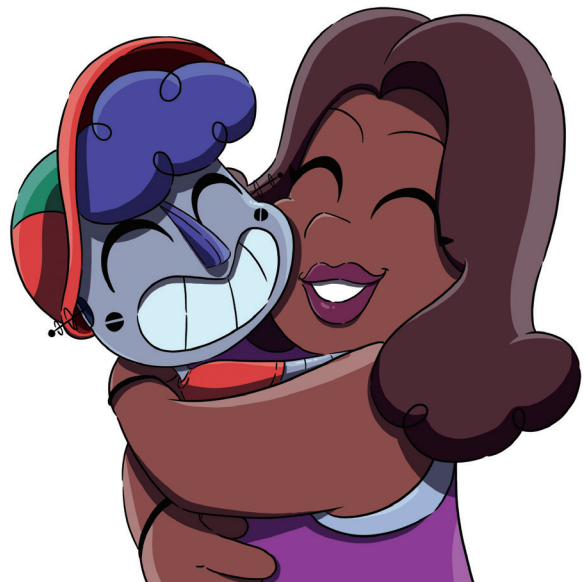
