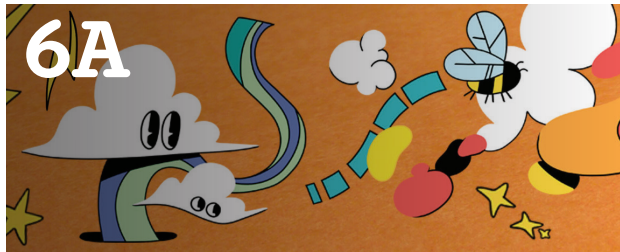

* This pathway includes narrative writing instruction but does not address narrative writing sub-standards ELA.6.C.3.1c and ELA.6.C.3.1f. For additional narrative writing instruction that addresses these standards, we recommend Lessons 6, 16, 20–21, and 23–24 in the Beginning Story Writing unit.

† To ensure full coverage of the Applications of Reading and Written and Oral Communications standards, we recommend using part of each Flex Day to work on vocabulary or grammar instruction. There are a total of 14 Flex Days in which to cover 2 Applications of Reading standards: ELA.6.AOR.8.1b and ELA.6.AOR.9.1, as well as 4 Written and Oral Communications standards: ELA.6.C.4.1b, ELA.6.C.4.1d, ELA.6.C.4.1e, and ELA.6.C.4.1g. See the Grammar Unit Topics for suggestions about how to sequence grammar instruction.

‡ This essay provides a choice of two prompts. To ensure full standards coverage, assign the argumentative prompt.
