
Setting up groups in mCLASS Intervention

Note: Prior to grouping, assess all students in mCLASS.




Step 1: mCLASS Intervention

Log in to <u>learning.amplify.com</u>, select mCLASS, and then Intervention on the top ribbon. When you're on the mCLASS Intervention landing page, select "Create Groups".


Step 2: Select the classes and design the groups

Select the classes to be grouped. Click "Next Step". Click on all the boxes under "Risk Level" that have a number in parenthesis to the right of the demographic. Choose the preferred group size. We recommend no more than 4 students per group. Choose the number of groups by dividing the total number of students to be grouped by 4. Click "Create Groups".



There are three approaches to grouping within mCLASS intervention:

- within a class.
- cross-class.
- cross-grade.



Step 3: Save the groups

Groups will automatically populate based on skills needed. Adjust the students in the group if needed by dragging and dropping into different groups.

Change the group names if needed and select the tutor for each group, then select Save Groups.

The system will save the groups and bring you directly to the groups page which gives you access to the lesson plans and student data reports.
