## Step 1: mCLASS Intervention

Log in to [learning.amplify.com](https://learning.amplify.com), select mCLASS, and then Intervention on the top ribbon. When you're on the mCLASS Intervention landing page, select "Create Groups".

## Step 2: Select the classes and design the groups

Select the classes to be grouped. Click “Next Step”. Click on all the boxes under “Risk Level” that have a number in parenthesis to the right of the demographic. Choose the preferred group size. We recommend no more than 4 students per group. Choose the number of groups by dividing the total number of students to be grouped by 4. Click “Create Groups”.
