

Summer Benchmark







The mCLASS **Summer benchmark window** will be available in the assessment system for the dates selected on your Reading Camp Survey. We will be using the same process as the previous two years, we will not be using Progress Monitoring.

The pre-assessment for Reading Camp will be the student mCLASS EOY Composite score.


The post-assessment for Reading Camp will be Summer Benchmark in mCLASS. The Summer Benchmark window is accessed the same way BOY, MOY, and EOY are, under mCLASS Assessment on the teacher device.

Reading Camp Assessment



- Grade level EOY forms are used during the Summer window
- Both DIBELS 8 Benchmark and Progress Monitoring measures are available to administer during the Summer window
- Once all DIBELS 8 Benchmark measures are completed in the Summer window, a Composite score appears on teacher's device
- This year, student data will also be available in classroom reporting
- Composite score calculation is the same that is used during EOY
- Summer benchmark goals are the same as <u>EOY benchmark goals</u>

You will be prompted to assess all necessary measures needed to calculate a Composite Score for Summer Benchmark.

Please note, during the Summer window, you should assess students using the End of Year (EOY) student materials for their current grade.




Teachers will access the Summer Benchmark in the Assessment platform.



Student materials can be found by accessing the Programs & Apps Menu, clicking on the PD Library, and then going to the mCLASS section.






Grade 2 and 3: Maze

Reading Camp: Data Reporting Updates




NEW for the 24-25 Summer Window, reporting will be available in the **classroom reporting view!**

Reading Camp data will **not** be available in any reports within the Reporting and Analysis (RAS) Suite (including the Download Your Data (DYD) raw extract).

Data will be **viewable and printable** for staff **at the classroom or group level** and viewable on the assessment app.

Amplify will still send NCDPI official Reading Camp data, but districts and schools are now able to use these reports to support internal and home/guardian reporting needs.

mCLASS Assessment App



Once all D8 measures are completed in the Summer window, a Composite score appears on teacher's device.

Cut-points in Summer BM period are the same as in EOY.


Composite score calculation is the same one that's used during EOY.

Data will appear in Classroom Reporting upon sync.




mCLASS available reports (PDF)

Current Page: prints view of entire Classroom (or group) reporting screen

Class Summary: prints only the class/group assessment data (composite and measures)

All Student Summaries: prints individual student data (one student per page and includes all TOY data, composite and measure level)

All PM Graphs: prints individual student PM data (one student per page and includes measures administered)



Reading Camp: Data Reporting

- Custom data reporting post-Reading Camp by Amplify
 - Reports will be sent to NCDPI
 - This is not an immediate data transfer
 - Amplify sends NCDPI data 4 times throughout the summer
 - NCDPI will distribute to districts/charters



- Student data is available in the teacher view on the mCLASS assessment app.
- Summer Benchmark data is **not** available in the Reporting Suite.
- Summer Data is available in Classroom Reporting.
- No raw extracts/CSV reports are available.





Each school is hosting their own Reading Camp




Teachers, Admin, and Specialists are all able to create groups in mCLASS.






